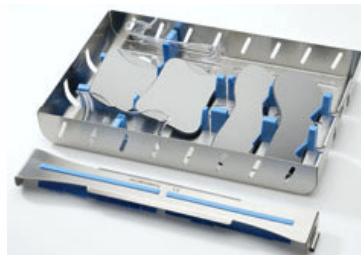

Why Digital Dental Photography

Digital photography has several significant advantages over the conventional photography.

- **Time:** Unlike the conventional cameras, where the practitioner has no idea about the quality of images before the film is developed, digital cameras can display the image instantly on a small LCD screen at the back of the camera. It is also possible to view the image on a larger TV or PC screen instantly, using the video out socket on the camera.
- **Cost:** Although the initial investment on the equipment is roughly comparable to the film cameras of similar quality, digital photography has almost no running costs. Shooting pictures has no costs at all; you can print only the ones you need, using a colour inkjet or laser printer, and you can simply delete the ones you do not want to keep.
- **Capacity:** With conventional cameras, you need to change the film every few dozens of shots. With digital cameras, you can shoot a lot more photos before you will need to transfer them from the camera to a PC. For instance, a 4GB memory card can hold 400 very high resolution images.
- **Storage:** The unit cost of electronic storage is constantly falling. You can store thousands and thousands of images on a hard disk taking no physical space, compared to stacks of boxes or shelves needed to store films and prints.
- **Manipulation:** Electronic images can be easily edited, annotated and their colour balance adjusted for illustration purposes. They can also be transported easily on a CD, DVD or by email.

The image quality and features of Package 1 (Canon EOS 400D) are practically identical to that of Package 2 (Canon EOS 30D). However, while former provides a light-weight solution perfect for clinical photography, the latter is a heavy-duty professional solution for more demanding environments.

The accessories include a set four mirrors, two plastic retractors, one narrow and one wide contrastor. Mirrors are front surface coated on both sides with Chromium, so that both sides can be used. The autoclave tray allows you to store and to sterilize your accessories. A self locking and removable steel and silicone holder holds your instruments in place.

While one camera set may be sufficient for a small multi-surgery practice, it will be useful to have one, maybe two, sets of mirrors for each practitioner. Although one tray is supplied with each package, the accessories tray is separately priced so that you can order according to the particular needs of your practice.
